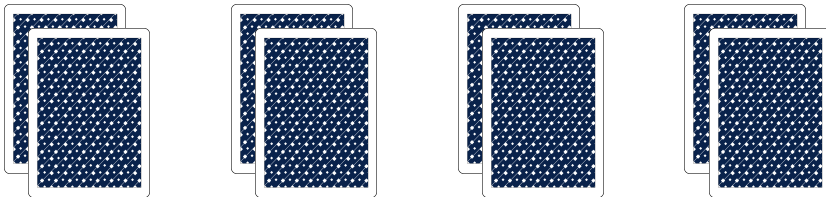


Puzzles, Games & Magic Trick

Setup: You need two face-down packets of four cards each. One packet has an A,2,3,4 in order, and the other has the same value cards in reverse (4,3,2,A) order. Place them face-down side-by-side on the table, and you're ready to begin.

Procedure:

- (1) While spelling P-U-Z-Z-L-E-S, for each letter you call out, move one card from the top of either packet to the bottom. If doing this for someone else, have them simply call out left or right after you say each letter, and use that packet.
- (2) Take the top cards of both packets together and place them aside in a pile.
- (3) Repeat the spelling procedure on the now 3-card packets, this time spelling G-A-M-E-S.
- (4) Again, take the new top cards of your packets and place those together aside in a separate pile.
- (5) Once again, repeat the spelling procedure but now with the word M-A-G-I-C.
- (6) Take the top cards of the packet and place those together in yet another pile.
- (7) Take the remaining two cards and put them together into one last pile.



Result: Turn over each pair of cards. The pairs will match in value.
