

Project Guidelines

The class project comprises two main parts:

1. Video Presentation (Due Sun May 2 by midnight)
2. Paper (Due Sun May 23 by midnight)

Video Presentation

- Due Sun May 2 by midnight
- Length: 6-20 minutes (each team member should speak at least 3 minutes)
- To be submitted via LEA: video file OR video/download link (Youtube, Vimeo, Google Drive, etc).

If you are just submitting a link, make sure that I have access to the files (I don't need to log in). Note that these video presentations will be viewed by the class, and the content will form part of the take-home test. Your video presentation can be just slides with voice-over but do your best to make it engaging. Please let me know if you have technical issues. The sooner the better.

As mentioned before, here are some useful simple tools that may help. They are by no means an exhaustive list. Use whatever tools you're most comfortable with:

- **Zoom** can record video and audio. You can switch between Speaker views and share slides (or other windows).
- **LOOM** (loom.com) is a tool that allows for easy screen recording/narrations. Your johnabbottcollege.net email address should give you PRO access.
- **Powerpoint** and **Google Slides** both have features to add audio to slides to varying degrees.

Paper

- Due Sun May 16 by midnight
- Length: 5-16 pages, not including full bibliography and cover page
- To be submitted via LEA (as DOCX, ODT or searchable PDF file)

Your paper should be more in-depth than video presentation, but should include all details from it. It can also include extra material that did not make it into the time-limited presentation. Your write-up should be cohesive, with an introduction and conclusion.

NOTE: If you're taking on a hands-on project, involving something like model building, programming, etc, then the requirements for the paper are VERY negotiable.
